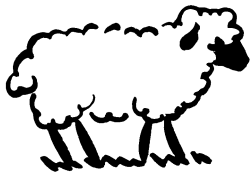
Words can have the same sounds but different meanings. Circle the word that matches the picture.



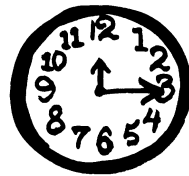

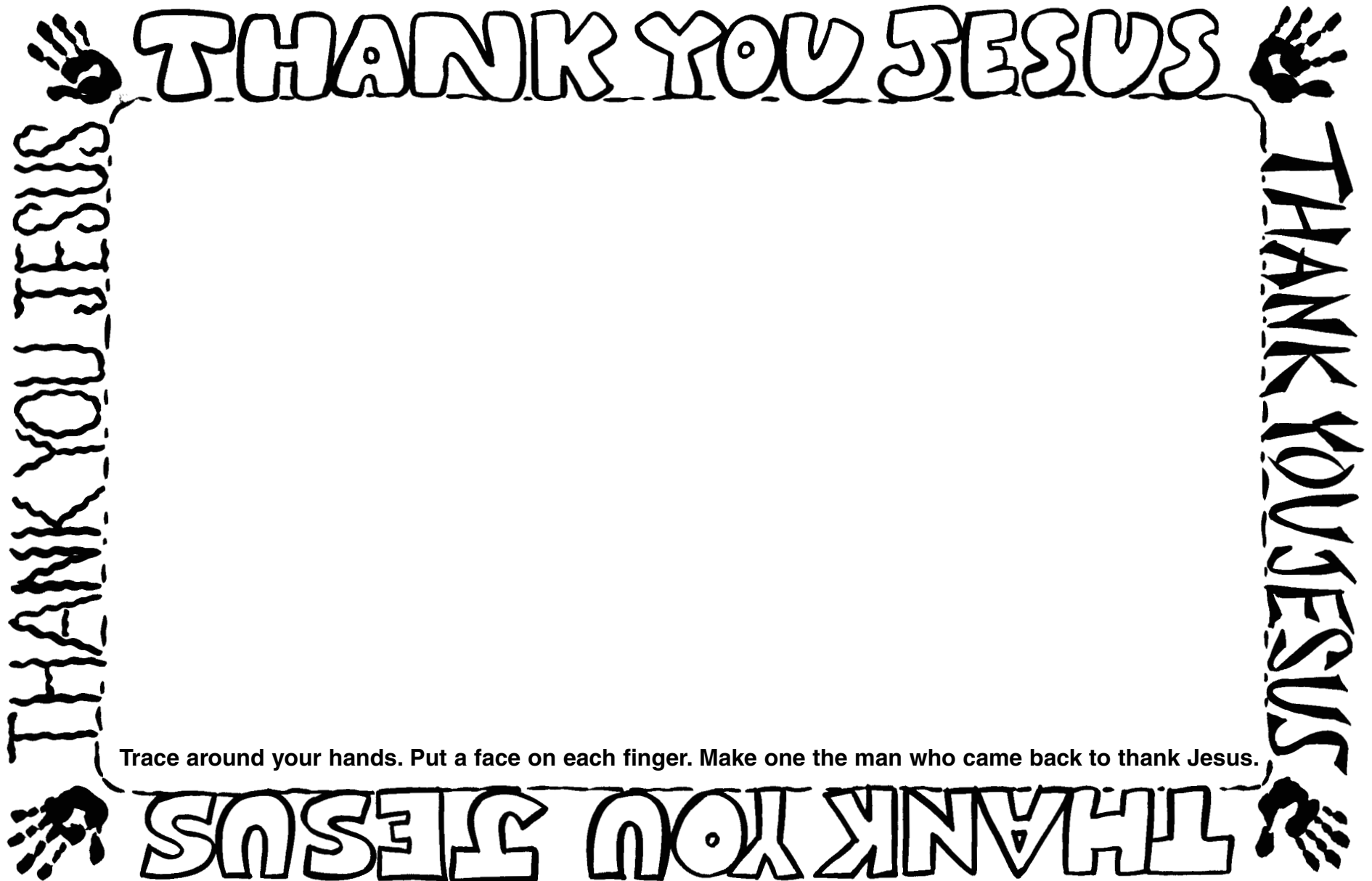
Welcome to worship. What time is it? Time to give thanks! Match the clocks with the correct scenes. What kind of prayer would you pray at each of these times?
